

Vote **NO**

on **Proposed Amendments 1 through 5** To the City of Bastrop's Charter¹

The effort to place the proposed amendments on the November 8th ballot was organized by a few individuals, led by a political operative who does not even reside in the City. We believe it has been fueled by their desire to remove one or more of **our duly elected** Bastrop City Council members.

These amendments are NOT being proposed by YOUR elected officials.

Bastrop's Charter stipulates that there be a *comprehensive* review of the charter every six years. *This review shall be based on a written report from the City Manager, with special attention given to conflicts, if any, between the Charter and state law, and recommending such amendments to the Charter as may seem necessary for legal, administrative or other reasons.*

It is time for such a comprehensive review of Bastrop's charter. It is NOT time for expensive special elections to make piecemeal changes that may or may not be wise or necessary and that will delay a comprehensive review.

Vote **NO** on **ALL** five propositions! Even if a single proposal passes, the State Constitution (Art.11) would prevent Bastrop citizens from voting on anything else regarding changes in our charter until November 2018.

A **NO** vote, on November 8, is a vote for a full review of our charter.

Early voting begins Oct. 24th; the special election day is Nov. 8th.
